#### Aim of the project:

To bring together all stakeholders across the resort to engage with the issue and deliver collective actions that will reduce the amount of single-use plastic entering the waste stream and ultimately the marine environment.

- Educating, raising awareness and encouraging behavior change among residents and tourists
- Embedding more sustainable practices within tourism business
- Building momentum for action and celebrating success stories



#### Quantitative targets

- Awareness-raising campaigns to reach around 700,000 tourists and 20,000 locals of the area
- Educational programme to reach at least 2,000 students
- Participation in the project: 70 hotels and 80 bars and restaurants

Plastic Waste-Free Islands Med International Union for Conservation of Nature

The project seeks to globally address the poorly addressed problem of plastic waste leakage from islands.

CSTI will in collaboration with the NGO Together Cyprus present the plastic pollution situation on the island in the following sectors: Tourism, Waste management, Fisheries.



- > 3-year initiative, part of the IUCN global Close the Plastic Tap programme
- > 13 target locations in the Caribbean, the Mediterranean and the Pacific
- the lessons learnt and experiences from the leakage reduction efforts in the 13 islands will be captured into a blueprint





Building Analytics and Diagnostics

- Domognostics + is about the creation of a software, suitable for "smart buildings", which is intended for the tourism industry.
- The purpose of the software is to control the building systems and reduce their operating costs (i.e. water leakages, energy losses, etc.)
- With the mission of promoting sustainable tourism, CSTI is a partner in this project, which aims to reduce the negative environmental impacts that are directly related to the proper management of resources.

# Climate Change

## The Climate Change Issue

"Human activities are estimated to have caused approximately **1.0°C of global warming** above preindustrial levels, with a likely range of 0.8°C to 1.2°C. Global warming is likely to reach 1.5°C between 2030 and 2052 if it continues to increase at the current rate"

*IPCC* (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change).

# The Climate Change Issue

#### What causes Climate Change?

• Carbon dioxide and other polluting gases

What is the solution today?

• Reforestation and ecosystem restoration

# Climate change in Cyprus

- Extreme weather phenomena and climate change have cost the Cyprus economy some €390 million over the period 1980 to 2016, of which only 2% was insured.
- The risks are not just monetary losses but also fires, floods, dust and coastal erosion among others.
- If temperatures rise by 2 degrees Celsius, Cyprus may face drought and coastal damage - the latter calculated at €9 million per year up until the year 2050.
- The EU is supporting the preparation of Cyprus' national adaptation programme

# Forest restoration is the best climate change solution

- The ability of trees to soak up carbon dioxide has long made them a valuable weapon in the fight against rising temperatures.
- The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) stated that if the world wanted to limit the rise to 1.5C by 2050, an extra 1bn hectares (2.4bn acres) of trees would be needed.
