What can you do to safeguard beaches while on holidays?

• If you smoke, please select the dedicated sun-lounger smoking zone, and use the ashtrays provided

 $\cdot\,$ Separate litter and place into the appropriate recycling or general waste bins dotted along the beach

· Use the water provided for showers and feet-washing sparingly

 \cdot Use the drinking fountain and minimise the use of plastic bottles on the beach

 $\cdot\,$ Have a walk through the green spaces and $\,$ find a variety of plants unique to this $\,$ part of Cyprus $\,$

 $\cdot\,$ Set your taste buds tingling by sampling traditional Cypriot dishes and produce from the kiosks and restaurants around the beach
