### The BeMed Project

"Plastic Free Entertainment Cruises and Water Sport Activities"

A <u>Sea and Beach Cleaning</u> organized by <u>CSTI</u> and the <u>Larnaka Tourism Board</u> with the support of the <u>Larnaka Municipality</u> and the <u>Deputy Ministry of Tourism</u>, took place in Larnaca on 11th November. Almost 1.5 tonnes of waste was collected from the sea and several bags of rubbish from the beach.

This is an initiative of the <u>TUI Care Foundation</u> delivered by the <u>Travel Foundation</u> in partnership with <u>CSTI</u>.
