The Results... from only 100 tourism businesses



Some encouraging results were a Reduction of:

- \*Plastic straws by 98.00% = 7.208.882 saved
- \*Plastic drink stirrers by 92.18% = 565.757 saved
- \*Plastic decorations by 96.02% = 119.400 saved
- \*Plastic drink coasters by 81.16% = 572.440 saved
- \*Plastic bottles for water by 30.60% = 1.864.382 saved








#### Online Public Consultation to discuss:

Coordinated action to mitigate climate change requires the development of an agreed action plan by the Deputy Ministry of Tourism, tourism industry partners with the participation of local authorities and the Department of the Environment to monitor the impacts of climate change and take measures to mitigate its effects.

Our Project Manager, Panagiota Koutsofta, was invited to speak at TEPAK's workshop on Endocrine Disruptors (EDCs) and their effect on human health and ecosystems. The actions the 'Keep our Sand and Sea Plastic Free' Project are implementing to reduce single-use plastics, especially in the coastal areas of Cyprus, were presented.

Fauna and flora have been significantly affected by the widespread use of EDCs, which are now detected in Cypriot ecosystems on a frequent basis, and through the food chain end up in humans.

A burning issue that concerns and affects us all.



### The outcome of the workshop was the creation of the 1st Cyprus Declaration on Endocrine Disruptors.

We co-authored recommendations for i) health professionals, and ii) to relevant government departments with the aim of reducing the impact of Endocrine Disorders (EDCs).


An ambitious Project with the intent to:


